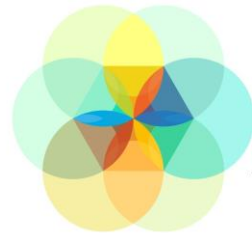

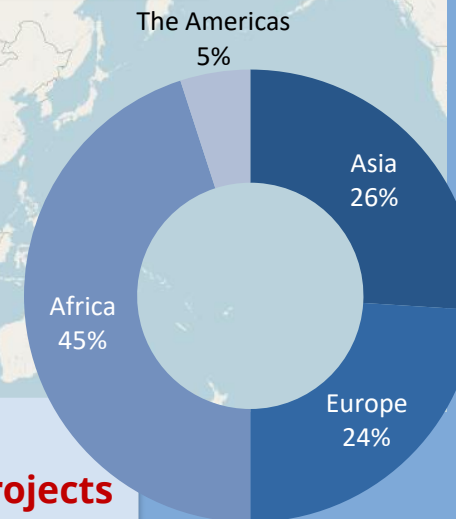

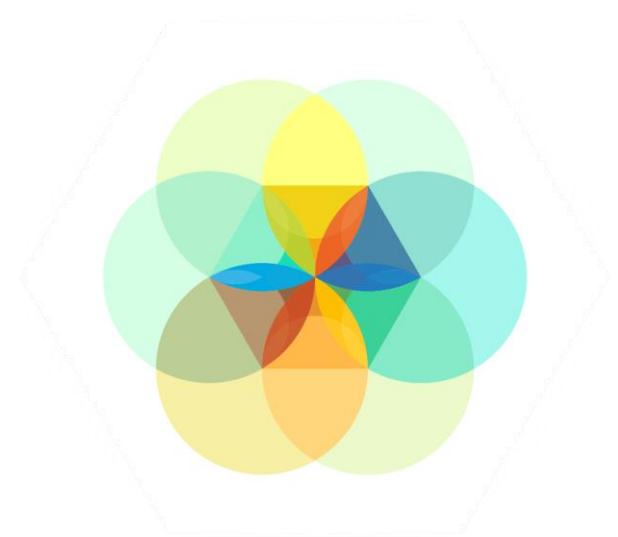

CLI would like to fill this gap, and for this reason has launched its **Transformative Partnership Award**



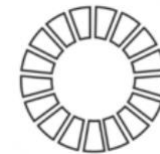
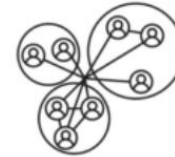

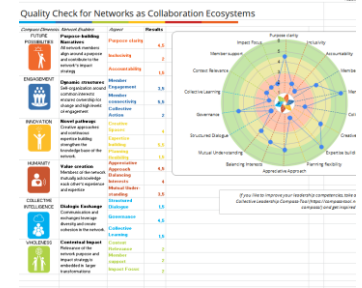
Eligibility criteria

Raise your (virtual) hand if you fulfil the following criteria:

- **not-for profit** or charitable status
- multi-stakeholder partnership
(at least **one more sector** involved)
- contributes to at least one **SDG**
- notable achievements for at least **two years**
- local, national, regional, global partnerships



Panel assessment criteria



- all relevant stakeholders are involved and an **added value for all** is created
- **ownership**, inclusive **communication**, and **governance** across all stakeholders
- **innovative** methods and results, **complementing** existing efforts to achieve the SDGs



Prizes

Stage 1:

All **eligible** projects – visibility (map, website, social media)

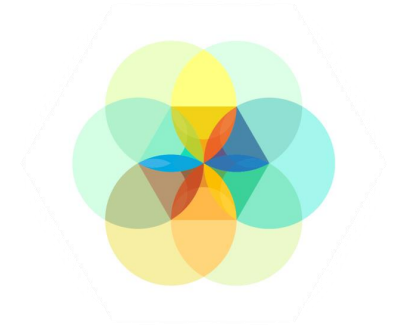
Stage 2:

All **shortlisted** projects – additional visibility (nomination button, award campaign), connectivity (jury event)

Stage 3:

Top 3 projects – a trip to Potsdam with Award ceremony during #TLC2025 on 4 April 2025 +

In September/October – Shortlist infos and request to hand in full application


Until 30 November – Deadline for full application, panel decision and online event nominating the top 3 will follow early 2025

Nomination for CLI Transformative Partnership Award 2025

The award is conferred for partnerships and programs with remarkable achievements during the two years preceding the current one. The Award will be presented by CLI Executive Directors to the individual or representative of the recipient institution during a special ceremony as part of the Transformation Literacy Conference in April 2025.

This nomination process will take you approximately 40 to 60 minutes.

You must complete the units "Basic eligibility, Basic information, Terms and Conditions, Information about the partnership, Overview of the partnership, Nomination submitted"

Application stage 1 - Basic eligibility

The award is conferred to partnerships and programs with remarkable achievements during the two years preceding the current one. Applicants to the award must be an organization or institution with not-for-profit or charitable status. They have to be official partners in the partnership, but do not have to be the lead organization. There is no restriction as to where the project takes place, or whether it is local, national, supra-regional or global in scope.

Organizations can nominate their partnerships here **until 31 August 2024**. Selected organizations will then be invited to submit more detailed descriptions of their partnerships **until 30 November 2024**. All information has to be submitted in English or German. Supporting documents may also be in French or Spanish.

The winning institution/organization demonstrates that their partnership successfully contributed to transformative change related to sustainability, meeting several or all of the following criteria:

- Developed a partnership action that contributed to one or more SDGs in a multi-stakeholder collaboration with stakeholders from at least two sectors (public, private, civil society)
- Created value for all stakeholders involved that is reflected in joint strategies and implementation plans
- Ensured ownership, inclusive communication and governance across all key stakeholders in the partnership
Creates innovative results that actively embed the partnership action in larger sustainability transformation efforts



- What was the change (structural, behavioral, cultural, individual) that was achieved, and why do you consider it transformative?
- What was the innovation and/ or unique added value that was only possible to be achieved in this partnership?
- What was your biggest challenge, and how did you address it?
- Why do you consider this partnership a contribution to sustainability?

Complete and continue

- Confirm „complete and continue“ to submit your application. You are done for stage 1! You may have a look at stage 2, but don't fill anything in yet (it will be deleted anyways on 1 September).
- You can start the application and continue anytime. You can also always jump back to an earlier stage until you have submitted a survey.

Tips for application

For stage 1:

be clear and precise with your **2-pager** and check what CLI likes in its work (**our approach** and **our impact pages on CLI's website**), don't be shy to **ask if you have a question**, don't try to be perfect (there will be a stage 2!), rather **authentic and innovative**

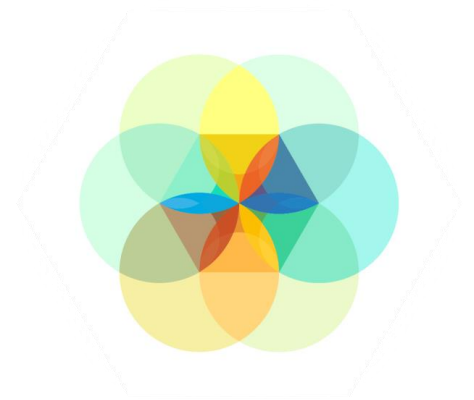
For stage 2:

the **panel** will be from **different sectors** (development cooperation, university, private sector, civil society), use your **full application** to convince them and **reply authentically and precisely** to their questions

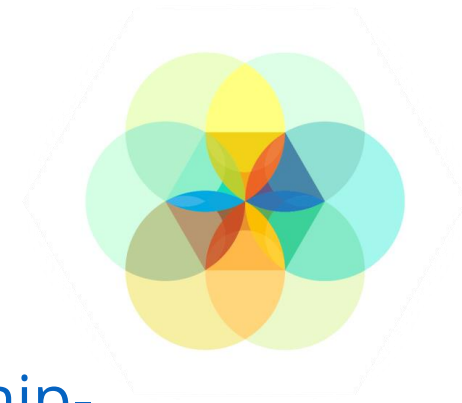
