**Tuition fee:** The amount is € 2.000 (7% VAT if required) for in-person participation and € 1,500 for online participation. You save € 150 for each format if you have signed up for the whole certification programme. The tuition fee includes the costs for technical instruction, the training sessions, access to all digital materials and the course book, and documentation of the training. In-person participants get additionally printed course books, a networking event, food and beverages during the coffee and lunch breaks.

**Mode of payment:** After your formal registration we will send you an invoice. The tuition fees will be due 10 days after receipt of the invoice, latest 2 weeks before the start of the course.
