Enlivening Narratives and Empowering Metrics

Transformation efforts through the lens of Governance and Democracy



Enlivening Narratives refers to needs such as

- Balance narratives of threat with **narratives of possibility**
- **'Leave no one behind'** in co-creating the future
- Make tangible steps towards the future vision **visible and possible** for all



Democracy and Governance lens:

- Develop **alternatives** to the **'might is right'** narrative
- Ensure **governance structures empower** all concerned, and support self-organization
- Create spaces for **tangible collective action** throughout all levels (local to global)





METRICS

Empowering Metrics refers to needs such as

- Make **progress visible**, alert to danger and ensure **relevance**
- Make the data **understandable, inspiring and practical** for a variety of stakeholders *NARRATIVES*
- Balance **objective and subjective** criteria





METRICS

Democracy and Governance lens:

- Combine **various forms of progress reporting**, ensure **relevance** for democratic narratives
- Make the data **accessible** and **supportive for action to all stakeholder groups**
- Ensure adaptation that allows **context specific progress and follow-up**



Narratives and Metrics – a key connection

- Metrics can **visualize progress or alert to danger**
- Can contribute to a narrative of **control or enablement**
- Consider **threat vs empowerment** narratives behind metrics (e.g. CO2 emissions, ecological footprint)

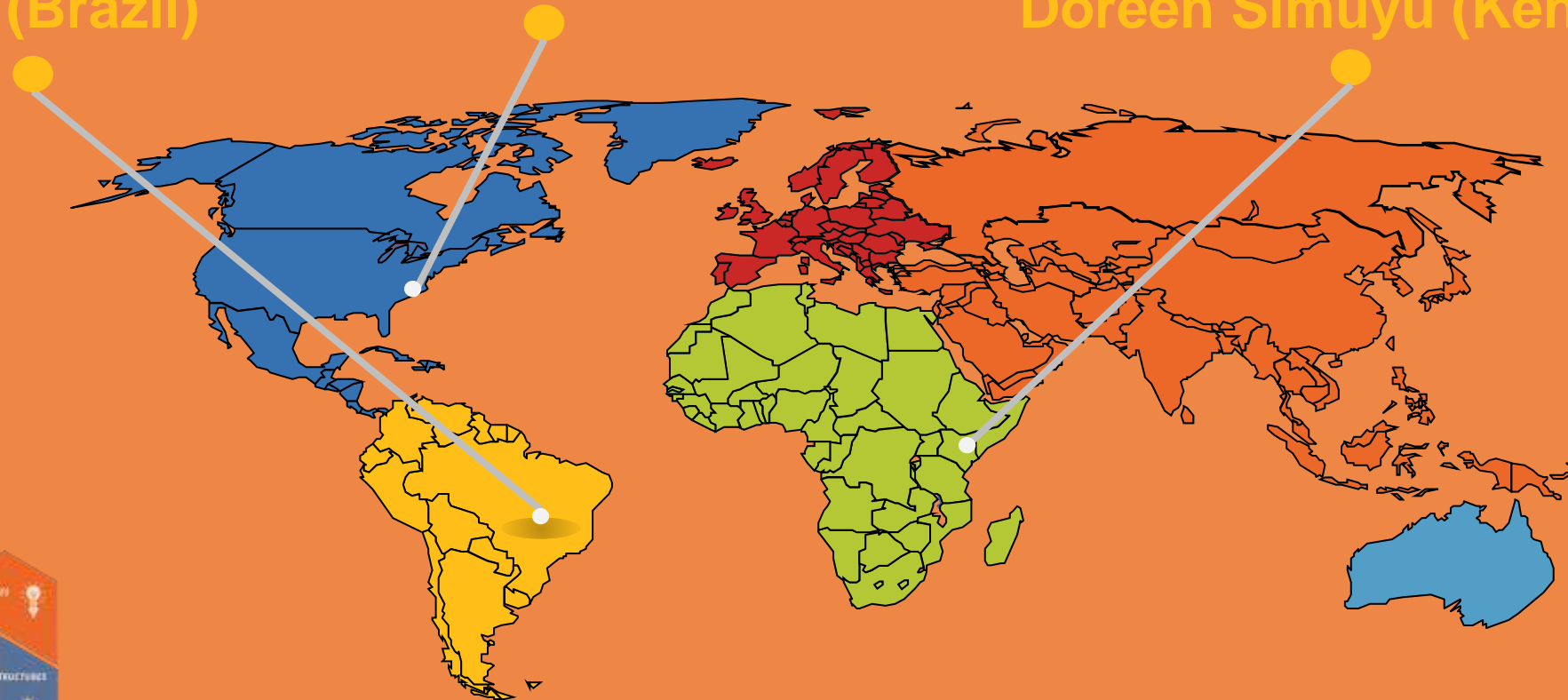
