



PROBLEM

- Russia's illegal invasion of Ukraine
- Suspension of energy imports to the EU
- German dependence on Russian energy imports





SOLUTION(?)

 2022 Parliament passed legislation to make Germany independent from Russian energy imports

• Example: Liquified Natural Gas (LNG) Acceleration Act reduced mandatory citizen consultation to one weeks and created exemptions to environmental impact assessments



SOLUTION (?)

Short-term: rapid construction of LNG infrastructure

Mid-term: suitable for switching to hydrogen ("green gas")

Long-term: limited duration of fossil energy infrastructure max. until 2043



CASE: LNG TERMINAL PROJECT ON THE ISLAND RÜGEN

- Ongoing protests by local communities and environmental groups
- LNG terminal near a wildlife reserve and tourist resort
- Final decision by the government is expected in the next few weeks
